

Suggestions for Tubs

Each year our mission teams build around 110 houses for poor families in Nicaragua. In addition to the homes, we ask each team to help supply much needed items for the families. We will provide household items, clothing, shoes, hygiene items, & school supplies for the families. We respectfully ask you provide new or gently used items for your adopted family. Please do not send things that are simply worn out. Following are suggested guidelines for your tubs. Tubs are provided by Project H.O.P.E. **Please label your tub as directed by your team leader. Tubs must be under 50 lbs.**

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

- Silverware
- Sharp kitchen knives
- Cooking utensils (spoons and ladles to use over an open fire)
- Pots and pans (iron skillet, etc...they cook over an open fire)
- Storage containers (Tupperware, Rubbermaid, etc.)
- Plates, bowls, & glasses (non breakable)...one place setting per family member
- Aprons
- Potholders
- Dish soap (in a one gallon Ziploc bag)
- Trash bags
- Dishtowels, dishcloths
- Clothespins/ Clothesline (nylon cord)
- Towels & washcloths
- Sheets...at least 2 large flat sheets
- Lightweight blankets
- Pitchers (non breakable with lids)
- Fish hooks & line
- Needle nose pliers; screwdrivers & screws; hammer & nails
- Flashlight and batteries
- Candles
