

Taellor's House Internship

Overview:

We are so glad the Lord has led you to learn more about Internships at Taellor's House. This opportunity is designed for young women who have a passion for sharing the love of Jesus. Interns will gain great experience in cross-cultural missions through purposeful involvement with the daily operations and care of children at Taellor's House. The school staff and intern team will work together to meet physical and spiritual needs of the families involved. The goal is that our team will provide a safe, loving environment for every child, and aim to share the hope of our Savior, Jesus Christ, with each family. It is our aim, that through deep personal study, ministry experience, and intentional discipleship, interns will grow in their own spiritual walk.

This Project H.O.P.E. internship is offered to females over the age of 18. Each selected individual will serve for a minimum of three months as missionary interns in Nicaragua. Our current internship program consists of 3 sessions (Spring, Summer, Fall), each lasting 3-4 months. While in Nicaragua, interns help the operations on the ground run more smoothly, ultimately helping Project H.O.P.E. continue its vision of bringing life transformation by meeting physical and spiritual needs. Interns will use their personal gifts and skill sets to share Christ's love with the children and families involved in our program.

Terms :

We will choose 4 to 6 interns per term.

Term 1- February 4- May 3, 2017

(Application deadline- October 1, 2016)

Term 2- May 13- August 9, 2017

(Application deadline- January 1, 2017)

Term 3- August 19- November 15, 2017

(Application deadline- March 1, 2017)

Financial Information :

Each intern is asked to raise their own living expenses, which includes the following:

- Housing
- Food- (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- In-country ground transportation
- T-Shirt and some discipleship material

This cost will total \$550 per month, or \$1800 for one 3 month term.

The cost of living will not include:

- Roundtrip airfare to/from Managua, Nicaragua
- Passport Fees
- Entry Fee- \$10
- Snacks/personal toiletries
- Personal recreational activities
- Health insurance/short-term mission insurance

Eligibility :

We ask that each applicant is a female, over 18 years old. Short-term missions experience is beneficial, and it is necessary to commit to a complete term of service.

Application Process:

1. Pray for God's guidance and leading, as you follow His call to missions.
2. Complete the application form.
3. Ask your Pastor, Youth Pastor, or Church Leader to write and send a reference letter.
