

We are so glad for your interest in an internship with Project H.O.P.E.!

This program is offered to young women interested in getting a mini-perspective of mission life through purposeful involvement with the daily operations of Project H.O.P.E.

As an intern for Project Hope, you will be given roles that will assist you in exploring and developing yourself spiritually and professionally, working alongside staff members and short-term mission groups. The program will provide many opportunities to delve into God's word both in groups and in personal study.

The following are just a few of the areas in which you will serve:

- Taellor's House (a Christian-based preschool)
- Hope Central (base operations and team support)
- Women's Ministry
- Children's Ministry
- Center of Hope (city dump)
- Medical Ministry

Eligibility: All applicants must be between 18-24 years old and have graduated from high school. Because of limited housing, we are currently only taking female applicants.

Each intern will be asked to cover their own living expenses of \$500 per month. These fees include:

- Housing
- Food (3 meals a day)
- In-country ground transportation
- Discipleship materials
- T-shirt

Fees DO NOT include:

- Roundtrip airfare to/from Managua, Nicaragua
- Passport fees
- Entry fee - \$10
- Visa extensions for those staying longer than 90 days
- Extra spending money for excursions, entertainment, personal toiletries, snacks or meals outside the Hope Central/Taellor's House provision.
- Personal medical insurance

Terms : We will choose 4 interns per term for the 2018 season.

Term 1- February 3- May 3 (Application deadline- October 1, 2017)

Term 2- May 19 - August 11 (Application deadline- January 1, 2018)

Term 3- August 18 - November 17 (Application deadline- April 1, 2018)

Application Process:

1. Pray for God's guidance and leading as you follow His call to missions.
2. Complete the application form.
3. Ask 3 people to write a reference letter for you. One should be from your Pastor.
4. Submit application and three reference letters to: cheri@pjhope.org.
5. After we receive your submission, you will be contacted to meet for a personal interview.
